

FEDERATION OF HISTORIC MOTORING REPORT

Meetings October and November 2009

At the recent meetings of the F.H.M.C. of S.A. the following points were discussed. For those new members who are unaware, our club and 130 or so others are affiliated with the Federation. It represents 15,000 members and 11,000 vehicles. The Federation acts on behalf on many issues including Historic Registration (HVRS), Bay to Birdwood Classic, special club runs, and insurance. Please note that my report is my own interpretation of the information given by either attendance at meetings or minutes of meetings. I don't expect all the issues I have outlined to be always relevant to us, but it gives some feedback on what the F.H.M.C. of S.A. represents.

- -The following matters were brought up at the meetings:
- All American Day is on the 21st February 2010 at Tilley Reserve, Surrey Downs.
- Apparently some people are getting Historic rego at Services SA without being a member of a club. This actually means that the vehicle is unregistered.
- If a logbook is lost a statutory declaration is needed to get a new one.
- The FHMC tour for 2011 is called the Regal Ramble. The event will be held in the South East.
- At the Bay to Birdwood Classic there were 1900 applications, 1800 approved, 100 did not turn up at the start, and 500 returned to Adelaide without stopping at Birdwood. The next event will be the 30th Classic.
- The age of drivers of veteran vehicles was raised and it has been suggested that younger people need to be involved by some type of promotion. This may help to get them back on the road.
- A brochure is available at Service SA that details information about handing in number plates on unregistered vehicles.
- There was an Occupational Health Safety and Welfare talk about the meeting hall. We need to do this at our meetings.
- The Rock and Roll Rendezvous is at the Birdwood Motor Museum on the 18th April 2010.
- Believe it or not. One non FHMC in the HRVS has been issuing log books from the local newsagent (over a period of some years) to is HVRS owners.
- It was mentioned how good it would be if clubs only have to decide wether a vehicle fits into the Historic rego scheme, or the Special interest vehicle scheme, rather than having to argue about modifications or variations.
- IMPORTANT: It has been reported that the Australian Insurance Council is moving to remove the clause for the owner of a vehicle to retain the right to keep a written off vehicle after an accident. Check your policy. Shannons has stated that it does not support such action and will not comply.

WALLY'S HISTORIC REGISTRATION QUESTIONS

WALLY: You've been on a lot about signing my book before I go take the car out each time.

Sometimes, I don't know where I'm going!

ANSWER: Give us a break! You'll have some idea of the area, so you can put a general note such

as Adelaide Hills Region or Yorke Peninsula. The rules are not that difficult.

WALLY: What if my mate drives the car? Who signs the book?

ANSWER: If your mate takes the car out on his own, it's probably better to let him fill in the log

book and sign it. If you are with him, so long as one person signs it, that seems to be

OK.

WALLY: So do the Police ever pull you up and check the log books? After all, most of us are

not tearaways!

ANSWER: You are just as liable to be stopped in a vehicle on HVRS rego as any other car.

Whilst some Police officers may not appear too familiar with the scheme, chances are that if they are looking to add to their "customer contacts", someone will latch on to it. I've been stopped, coming off the Freeway and others as they left a major event.




23rd January 2010 Club Run

Happy New Year! Here's hoping 2010 is good to you and your Holden.

That's right, it's January 1, which means you have only 30 days to get your entry in to be part of the 13th FE-FC Holden Nationals.

The 13th FE-FC Holden Nationals will be held over the Easter weekend 2010. The event is being hosted by the FE-FC Holden Car Club of NSW, and celebrates the 50th anniversary of Touring Car Racing in Australia, at the birthplace of the ATC Championship, the Gnoo Blas Circuit in Orange, NSW. The Nationals are a full weekend of early Holden entertainment, with meals, a super-cruise, a street display and the Show 'n' Shine. The event will culminate on Easter Monday with a lap of Mt Panorama in Bathurst.
